

Guidelines for Contributors

The Journal of Bangladesh Institute of Planners (JBIP) welcomes the submission of papers relating to all aspects of urban, regional and rural planning in developing countries, especially Bangladesh, but papers on the following key topics will be particularly welcome. Urbanization and related planning issues; housing; transport and communications; regional development and planning; rural development and planning; community health and planning; geographic information system; planning techniques and methodologies and the administration of planning and development.

Two copies of manuscripts should be submitted, typed with lines double spaced and with wide left hand margins. Please use 21.6cm x 27.9cm white paper.

An abstract not exceeding 200 words should accompany the manuscript. The abstract should be placed before the introduction.

References should be cited in the text by putting the author's name followed by the year of publication with bracket as shown below :

- a) The Technique in the first place (Richardson, 1928)
- b) Stillwell (1969) emphasizing the need
- c) 'Region to region works' (Herzog and Olsen, 1977 P.445).

Notes and references should be typed at the end of the article. Notes should be placed before references, References should be listed in alphabetical order to author's last name as shown below :

Ashby, L.D. 1970. "Changes in Regional Industrial Structure : A Comment". Urban Studies, 7(3): 298-304.

Wilson, A.G. 1970. Entropy in Urban and Regional Modelling. London : Pion.

Tables should be sequentially numbered in the order in which they are referred to in the text, and should be included in the text. Each table should have a brief descriptive title and source.

All maps, diagrams, and charts should be referred to as 'Figures' and should be numbered sequentially in the order in which they are referred to in the article. All figures should have brief descriptive captions.

An article accepted for publication in this journal must not be submitted to other journals and once published, it must not be reprinted in whole or part in any form without the Editor's written permission.
